On August 29 I reached out to you for prayer, as we had just received word from our doctor that Margi had a large cancerous tumor embedded in her liver. This was a difficult moment for both us and our church here in Buenos Aires. Margi did have her surgery on September 5, and according to the surgical team, it was successful. We felt the presence of the Lord with us at every moment. We also had

great support from our church here in BA.

On September 23, Margi returned to her surgeon for reports on the biopsies of the tumor and surrounding tissue. It was a really great report. It is definitely liver cancer (which we already knew). The key to this visit was that the surrounding tissue was clear. There were no cancer cells. Truly, this is an answer to prayer. She will be returning to her tumor specialist to find out what the next steps are. As of yet, we don't know if there will be chemotherapy. There is a 5-year monitoring period, as with all cancers. She will have a CT Scan/MRI every 3 months. Please pray with us that the work our precious heavenly Father has started, He will complete. We cannot thank you enough for standing with us in these challenging moments. As Margi says today, she is alive and laughing.
